Hello Members,

The start of the new snowmobile season is here. I know the weather is still rather nice, but the nights are cooling down and as I write this I hear there is frost warning for north central Minnesota. Club, region and state meetings have started. And the fall is loaded with snowmobile events, which are listed in this newsletter,

The biggest news on trails is the club's RTP (Recreational Trails Program) grant has been approved. This grant will fund 80% of our future groomers cost. The other 20% of funding will come from a STEF (Snowmobile Trail Establishment Fund) grant which were still waiting on. No decision on the STEF yet due to the State of Illinois lack of a budget. There's not enough space to write about my opinion on that here. Contact your law makers and encourage them to pass a budget.

The club again this year has a fund raiser, we are selling raffle tickets same as in the past. Only 700 tickets sold at a cost of \$10.00 each, with 3 prizes being given away, First prize \$2000.00, 2nd prize \$200.00 and 3rd prize of \$100.00. So make sure to take a SEP class so you have your card when it's time to ride.

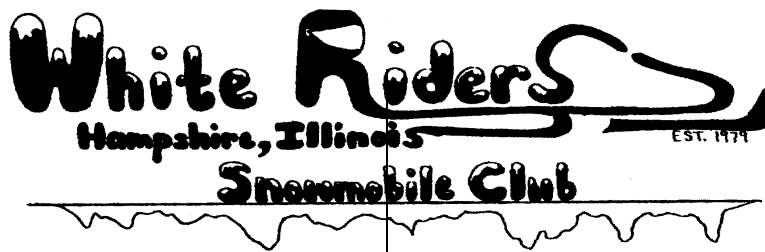

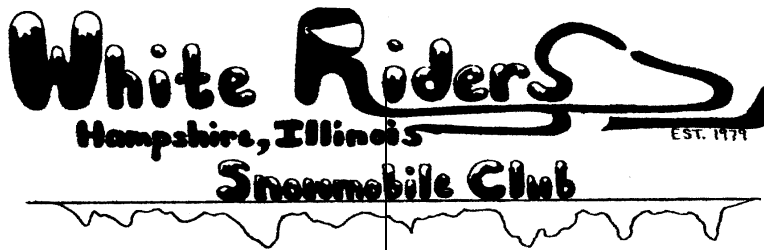
CLUB TRIPS SCHEDULED
